While we are facing unprecedented times, it is important that your family has a place to support their students' needs and academics. Starting in a new school or returning to one is an opportunity to *Commit to a New Beginning*. Peninsula High School will say goodbye to our 300 Piedmont Avenue location on November 6th and move to our new location in Burlingame starting Trimester #2 on Thursday, November 12th. On behalf of the faculty, staff, and administration of Peninsula High School, we would like to welcome all students, new and returning, to PHS. Your student will begin classes the week of August 17-21st at PHS. As our time at Orientation is limited administration will be focusing on sharing safety protocols and student expectations. - PHS will be distributing student technology on **August 3rd (GROUPS #1 and #2) between 8am-12pm (noon)** in the library
- PHS will be distributing student technology on **August 4th (Groups #3 and #4) between 8am-12pm (noon)** in the library
- These devices will remain with each student through graduation. Students are responsible for these devices, must take good care of them, and report if there are any technical problems with them immediately.
- Please arrive at your designated time and be prepared to follow social distancing safety protocols during the process. ALL STUDENTS AND PARENT/GUARDIANS must bring face masks/coverings to the school checkout process.
- *Beginning August 17 during Orientation week, students will receive further instructions on how to use their Chromebook devices for completing their coursework.*

Peninsula High School takes great pride in providing the very best in continuation education. We strive to make our school a place that honors individual differences, nurtures self-esteem, and fosters both trust and mutual respect. Our goal is to present opportunities for success, and aspire for each student to meet their goals. At orientation, we'll share how we will meet your student's needs while instruction is remote. We have a unique credit recovery, and intervention program that is tailored to each individual's needs. Your child's goal may be a PHS diploma, or return to their home school; whatever their goal may be, we are here to support them. Every student will have a fourth period academic, and social/emotional support class designed to help them meet the demands of school and provide the skills to be successful in their high school classes and beyond.

Students will be able to take career preparation and training classes in at least one of the areas below:

- Courses: FLY Leadership Program and Law & Society
- Courses: Food and Nutrition, Food and Hospitality Services and Culinary Arts
- Courses: Digital Photography
- Courses: Senior Level College Study Skills

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **MANDATORY ORIENTATION FOR ALL STUDENTS** will occur from **Monday, August 17th – Thursday, August 20th** and begin **PROMPTLY @ 7:45 AM until 12:00 PM (NOON):**
(ATTACHED is YOUR "ASSIGNED GROUP" and DAY you will have ORIENTATION. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ATTEND with your "ASSIGNED GROUP."
- **Attendance is mandatory** for *new and returning* students to the orientation, and parent(s)/guardian(s). Orientation will be in the Peninsula H.S. library/quad. You will have an opportunity to meet with your administration in person, and our PHS support staff, as well as teachers on Zoom, who can answer any questions you may have. Parents/Guardians should plan on attending orientation from 7:45 am - 9:00 am and may come back at noon should they wish to pick-up their student.

- **First Day of the 1st Trimester:** Friday, August 21st, 2020 at 9:00 AM.
- **Student Handbook:** The Student/Parent Handbook is an informational resource for your use and covers all pertinent information regarding P
- Peninsula High School curriculum, resources, rules & regulations, and our administration, faculty, and staff. The handbooks are available on our website <https://www.smuhsd.org/peninsulahigh>. Please take a moment to read and become familiar with our school.
- **Fourth Period Academic and Social/Emotional Support Courses:** Every student will be able to work on their academic skills and preparation through structured lessons, group collaboration, and evaluation of student growth. Classes include access to a variety of counseling services and supports, restorative justice practices skills, math and reading support, college study skills, meditation/reflection, online work, guided studies classes, COVID19 support, and on occasion, participate in Restorative Justice Practices. Each class will address similar topics, but in different depths based on the student's needs. During this time, students will receive individual and group counseling, addressing their own social and academic needs. In addition, each senior will take a twelve-week transition course where they will all receive college credits, and preparation for community colleges and life skills for after high school.
- **Attendance:** Students must be in class, on time, whether in remote learning on Zoom, or in-person/class direct teacher instruction, on-site, taking full advantage of the opportunity to learn and accumulate credits necessary for graduation. Please schedule all personal and non-school related appointments outside of school hours.
- **Clearing Absences:** Peninsula High School has an automated phone dialer system. You will receive a phone call for each period absence, and/or tardy, as soon as the teacher submits the attendance into the school system. It's possible for you to receive up to 6 phone calls for each of the class periods on a day a student is absent. Clearing absences as soon as possible will prevent any unnecessary phone calls. Please call in all absences to **558-2408**. A permit to leave, and admit policy is in place for legitimate period absences. If you have any questions regarding the phone calling system, or believe there has been an error, please call the attendance clerk at **558-2408** as your contact information may need to be updated. This process will be clarified at orientation and how procedures will be different during remote learning.
- **Bus Transportation:** PHS provides bus transportation to and from school. All students ride the bus for free. Students will have the opportunity to access buses, and campus on their "Group" dates for classes whether they are held in person, or remotely. Please check our website for a list of bus stops. (Please refer to the printed bus schedule in the Student Handbook, or visit our website).

- **Bell Schedule/Trimester Schedule**
 - Trimester #1: Begins Friday, August 21st, 2020 - Ends Friday, November 6th, 2020.
 - Trimester #2: Begins Thursday, November 12th, 2020 - Ends Friday, February 26th, 2021.
 - Trimester #3: Begins Monday, March 1st, 2021 - Ends Wednesday, May 26th, 2021.

- **Food:** Meals will be provided and free for students. Students **MUST** have their Student ID with them to receive free meals. With student ID entitles students to two “free” meals of breakfast or brunch, and lunch.


- **Additional Class Option: For the 2020-21 School Year, every student** will be assigned six classes unless they are in their last trimester, or participating in work experience. All students participating in athletics at the comprehensive sites will be required to be enrolled in a 6 period day. Students will have the option to have a 5 period day if they participate in at least one of the following:
 - **School community service, volunteering and work experience:** Students have the option of earning elective credits by performing community service, volunteering, or working.
 - **Dual Enrollment with a Community College:** High School students tuition fees are waived.
 - **Night School Enrollment with the San Mateo Adult School:** Credit recovery option for 12th grade students who are deficient in lower grade level English and Social Science.
 - **Completion of at least one class on Compass Online Learning IF behind to graduate on time in May 2021.**

- **Graduation Requirement school year 2020-21:**
 - All students prior to graduation must fulfill the graduation requirement of completing 72 hours of Work Experience, or 24 hours of community service.
 - To fulfill this requirement, work, or community service should be completed in relation to the CTE pathway in which they participated.
 - If conditions to accessing a job or community service are impacted by COVID19, administration will make the final decision of whether these credits would be waived in March 2021.

We understand these are uncertain and challenging times, but the Puma Family is prepared to meet all of your educational needs. We look forward to a successful transition, or return to Peninsula High School, and again, welcome to our school.

 - Administration will share what the daily protocols, and procedures will be for students during both remote, and in-person learning.

 - While students go through their orientation with their classes, the parent/guardian will be able to observe classes and meet separately with administration.

What is Remote Learning?

- Meeting with Teachers is only virtually on Zoom during designated class times.
