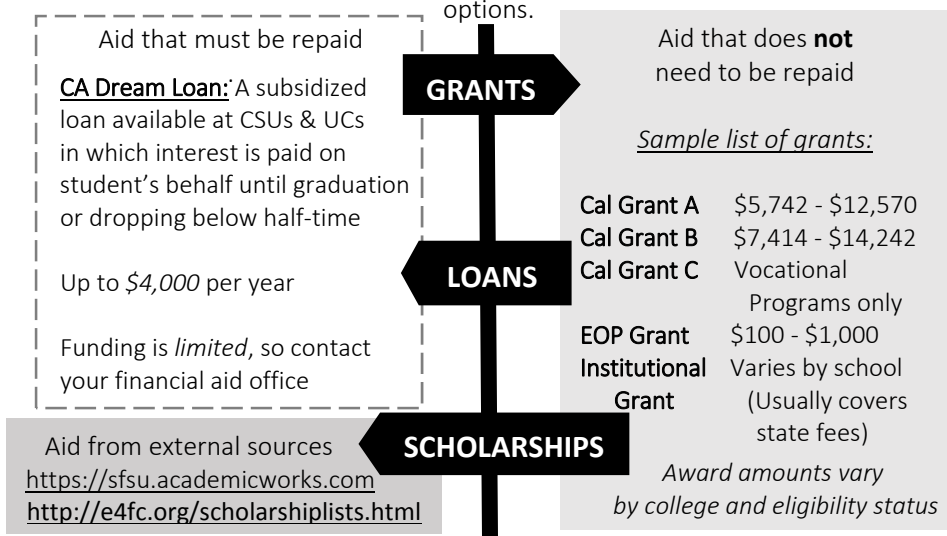


AB 540 STUDENT FINANCIAL AID & RESOURCES

What kind of financial aid can I receive?

Undergraduate students can apply for CA State financial aid programs. Please note that, depending on your college, your state grants may not be enough to cover your tuition. Do not forget to determine your budget and look into alternative options.



Contact the financial aid office at your college to receive cost of attendance and financial aid program information.

How can I apply for financial aid?

- 1 File your CA Dream Act Application online at <https://dream.csac.ca.gov>
- 2 Submit a GPA verification form to the CA Student Aid Commission at www.csac.ca.gov
- 3 Submit any follow up documents to your college if requested

To receive financial aid every year...

1. **RE-APPLY** for aid every year (Application opens October 1st)
2. **OBSERVE** March 2nd deadline to be considered for all aid programs
3. **MAINTAIN** satisfactory academic progress towards a degree

How much does college cost?

An estimated per-year cost of attendance comparison chart by institution type

Registration fees and tuition are based on full-time enrollment for CA residents. Fees and tuition are subject to change without advance notice. *Non-CA out-of-state and international residents must pay additional registration fees. Students who meet the

AB 540 requirements and submit both an affidavit and official high school transcripts can be exempted from out-of-state fees.



The costs of books and supplies, transportation and personal expenses are estimates that may vary campus to campus.



Total expenses may be less for students living at home. Financial aid is available to help students cover some of the college costs.
