It has many applications in biology and chemistry, and our programs have shared the large, old spectroscopy machines (Spec 20) for many years. A new Spec 20 costs about \$1,000 and wears out after 10-20 years. This new Spectrovis costs half as much as the older model, is simpler and faster to use, and allows us to investigate science concepts faster and in more detail. It also lets students ask questions, investigate, and explore science concepts in both biology and chemistry at all levels.	900	Yes
