LGBTQ youth are at a heightened risk for suicidal behavior, which may be related to experiences of discrimination, family rejection, harassment, bullying, violence, and victimization. It is therefore especially important that school staff be trained to support at risk LGBTQ youth with sensitivity and cultural competency. School staff should not make assumptions about a student's sexual orientation or gender identity and affirm students who do decide to disclose this information.
